

Figure 1. On-Region Characteristics




Figure 3. On-Resistance Variation vs.
Drain Current and Gate Voltage




Figure 5. Capacitance Characteristics




Figure 2. Transfer Characteristics




Figure 4. Body Diode Forward Voltage Variation vs. Source Current and Temperature





Figure 6. Gate Charge Characteristics

Figure 7. Breakdown Voltage Variation vs. Temperature





Figure 9. Maximum Safe Operating Area vs. Case Temperature



**Figure 11. Maximum Drain Current** 




Figure 8. On-Resistance Variation vs. Temperature






Figure 10. Eoss vs. Drain to Source Voltage Switching Capability




**Figure 12. Transient Thermal Response Curve** 








# **Resistive Switching Test Circuit & Waveforms**





**Unclamped Inductive Switching Test Circuit & Waveforms** 





#### Peak Diode Recovery dv/dt Test Circuit & Waveforms






Body Diode Forward Voltage Drop
